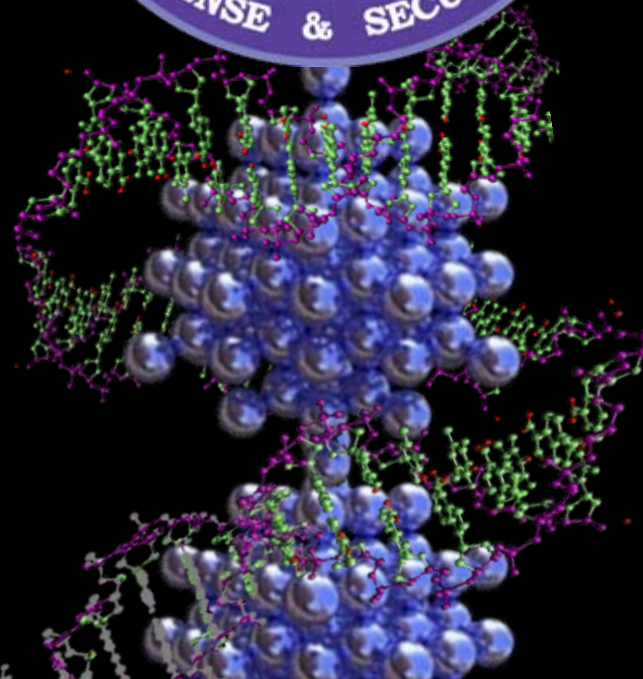

The 2009 NANO-DDS Exhibit is being organized as a companion event to the 2009 Nanoelectronic Devices for Defense & Security Conference (NANO-DDS) at the request and encouragement of the official organizers of the 2009 NANO-DDS.. The main goal of this exposition is to promote new interactions between scientists and technologists from university and government laboratories and their counterparts from industry that have new or evolving technology that will be useful in advancing the state-of-the-art nanoelectronic devices that have direct relevance to critical capability needs for national defense & security in the future.

In particular, the **2009 NANO-DDS** seeks to unify and focus the very broad array of nanoelectronic and supporting nanotechnology activities that are currently engaged in reaching the long expected application payoffs in core defense and security related areas such as sensing, data processing, computation and communications.

The expectation is that the 2009 NANO-DDS Exhibit will provide a fertile environment and work in concert with the 2009 NANO-DDS Conference to:

- create new technology-program networks that will serve as a research and development foundation for the advancement of nanoelectronic devices and applications for Defense, and
- foster new program/funding opportunities to develop nanoelectronic devices and applications.

2009 NANO-DDS Exhibit Information

Basic Information (note that the Exhibit will run directly in parallel with the 2009 NANO-DDS from 7:30 am September 29 to 1:00 pm October 2, 2009 and will be co-located and coordinated)

- (1) Exhibitor space of approximately 8' x 10' will be offered for \$2000 each in the Commodore Complex.
- (2) The layout of the Commodore Ballroom Foyer and meeting rooms is shown on the attached diagram.
- (3) If requested, the Exhibitor will be provided with a 3' x 8' table and 2 chairs .
- (4) Exhibitors will be allowed to start setting up their space at 6:00 pm on Monday, September 28, 2009.
- (5) Exhibitors must have all their equipment removed by 5:00pm on Friday October 2, 2009.
- (6) Note that purchasing a booth entitles the exhibitor to (2) discounted NANO-DDS registrations @ \$300. Additional registrations (>2) can be purchased online at the conference rate of \$550.

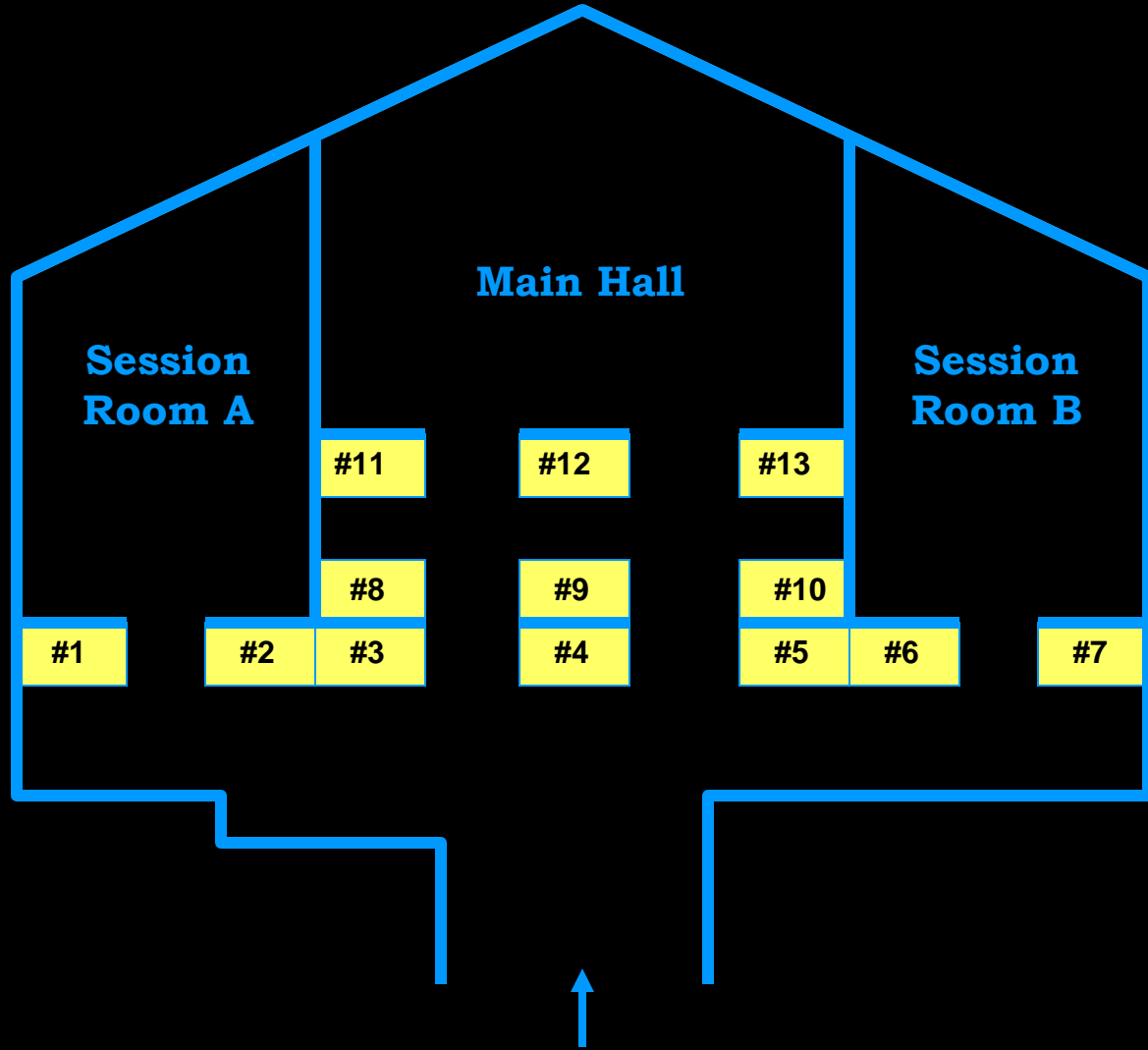
